The Erasmus+ project **access2learn** aims at giving all adults, regardless of their background, equal access to programmes of continuous development and thus contributing to their competitiveness on the labour market.

We want to overcome the prejudice that blended learning is not suitable for adults with a low level of qualifications.

**THEREFORE, IN THIS PROJECT, WE ARE FOCUSING ON TWO MAIN TARGET GROUPS:**

#### LOW-SKILLED ADULTS

We support them in getting easier access to blended learning offers and in developing the competences needed for blended learning.

#### ADULT EDUCATORS

We build awareness that blended learning should be offered to all adults, regardless of their level of qualification, and we support them in preparing low-skilled adults for blended learning.

#### 1 RAISING AWARENESS

We create a policy paper to break the prejudice that low-skilled adults are not able to participate in blended learning settings and a catalogue containing the competences needed for blended learning.

We create learning materials that support adult learners in developing competences required for a successful participation in blended learning settings.

#### 3 TRAINING

We develop various materials to support adult educators in preparing their learners for blended learning: an assessment tool, a seminar design, podcasts and a manual for the use of all materials.
